RESUMPTON OF AREA PLANNING AND PRE-PUBLICATION CONSULTATION ON DEVELOPMENT PROPOSAL
NO 625, BALLYNURE PRIMARY SCHOOL

Development Proposal No 625 - Ballynure Primary School

On 11 March 2020, the Education Authority began the pre-publication consultation process in relation to the undernoted proposal in accordance with Article 14 of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1986:

Ballynure Primary School will increase its admissions number from 22 to 30, with an increase in the enrolment number from 154 to 210 with effect from 1 September 2023, or as soon as possible thereafter.

However, as all non-business critical services, including Area Planning, had been stood down temporarily in light of Covid-19, the Education Authority suspended this pre-publication consultation. Approval has been given to resume area planning and the pre-publication consultation on the above Development Proposal will now re-start and run for a full 8 weeks from 6 May – 1 July 2021. All written responses already received to this consultation have been held on file and carried forward. Under the above legislation, the Education Authority is seeking the views/comments from the parents/guardians, staff and governors on the above Development Proposal.
