#### COVID-19

The Public Health Agency (PHA) is now the lead body responsible for contact tracing within schools. The Department of Education (DE) has informed school Principals that few, and in many cases no close contacts of a positive case of Covid will be identified in a child's class. PHA will not automatically inform me either. I will be relying on parents keeping me informed, immediately, if your child tests positive. Parents/cares have been tremendous in keeping school informed to date, so please continue to do so, in order that I can inform staff. DE has told schools/principals that we can no longer tell pupils to self-isolate as close contacts, even if children are all sitting close proximity to the child who has Covid. If you feel it appropriate through your parent WhatsApp groups, you may wish to share information that there is a case of Covid in your child's class. It will then be up to parents own discretion what action they feel is appropriate for their child.

Please keep school informed. Please be assured at school level we are trying to do our best to keep everyone in our school community safe.

#### **BREAKFAST CLUB**

PLEASE NOTE: Due to PHA Guidelines and continuing with our class bubbles, pupils are unable to attend Breakfast Club without having already confirmed their days attending, with payment having been made to the school office, on a Friday for the following week.

Please remind your child that he/she **MUST** stay **in their class bubble** throughout Breakfast Club.
