KS2 Parents - Text help Read&Write software

The EA has made available to all children software that supports your child when reading and writing text online. This software toolbar is particularly beneficial for children who experience spelling, reading or literacy difficulties and children with dyslexia. One helpful feature is that the software can read text to your child e.g. if they were completing a research project and it also uses predictive text to help them as they write online. You will need your child's c2k email address to access the software and Key Stage 2 children should know this. If your child is unsure of their c2k email address, please contact their class teacher.
