#### **SHOW NIGHT!**

On the nights of the shows, please adhere strictly to the following times. This will allow us to operate the shows in as smooth a fashion as possible:

All pupils should come to school with a water bottle. **Please note:** Parents will not be allowed access to the pupils during the interval.

#### **School Times**

On 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup> of March, school will close at 2pm to all pupils. Afterschool Club will be avaiable for all pupils on these days. This can be booked via ParentPay.

On 20<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> of March, pupils in P4-7 will have the option of coming to school at 10am. Younger siblings in P1-3 can also start at 10am.

P4&5 pupils play an important part in the show as a choir and as such, they are placed in a specific location. Being absent during a show upsets these pupil placements, which is difficult to fix at short notice. Plus, they are all exceptional at raising the volume of our songs!
